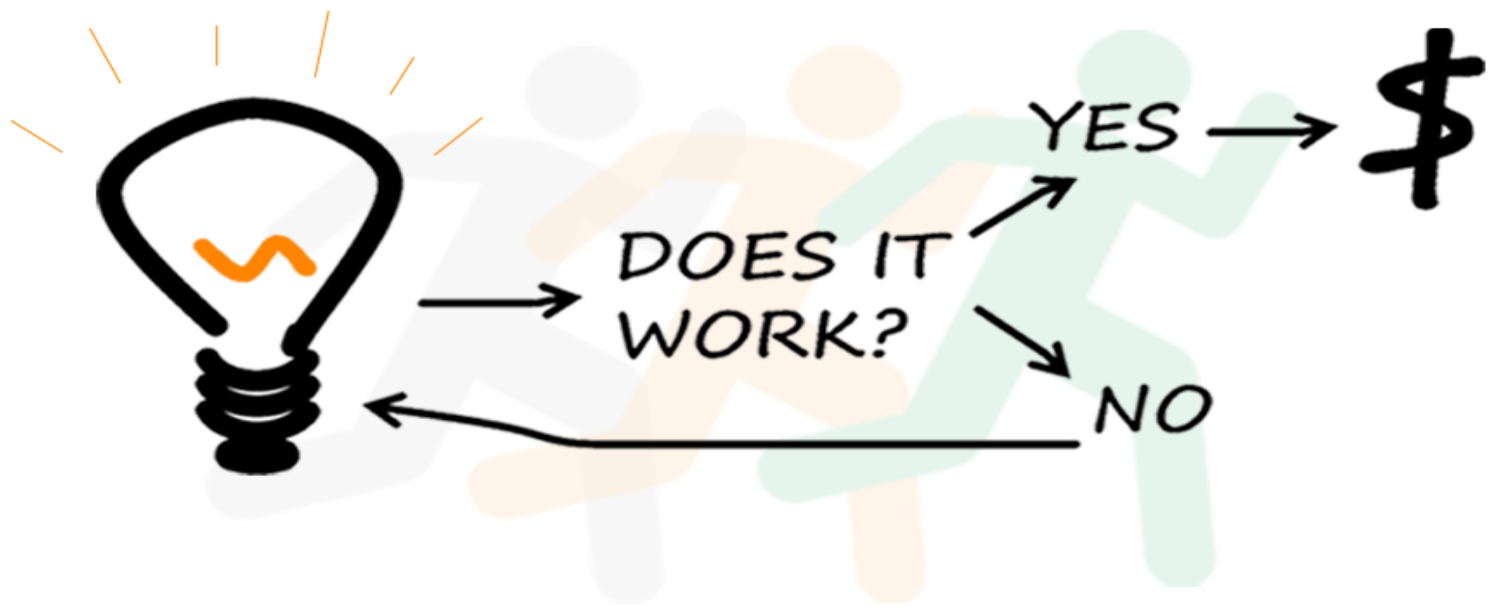

Fiverr- <http://www.fiverr.com> All types of jobs listed here start at \$5, with Level 2 sellers capable of selling additional services for more. Services include editing, video making, writing, graphic design, and more.

Elance- <http://www.elance.com> Many freelancers here in many different categories- can communicate with them on-site. You can pay part of the total amount of a job for each milestone that is completed, unlike most freelancing sites.

Guru- <http://www.guru.com> Have freelancers in graphic design, programming, writing, and more. The site will suggest specific “gurus” based on your project requirements.

Upwork- <http://www.updesk.com> Formerly known as Odesk.com, over 500,000 businesses use them, making them one of the most popular freelancing websites. You can request and review screenshots of a freelancer’s work while the project is worked on.

SolutionInn- <http://www.solutioninn.com> Similar to Fiverr’s set-up in that experts set up services and set fixed prices.

PeoplePerHour- <http://www.peopleperhour.com> Similar to Fiverr and SolutionInn in that freelancers can set up their services and set fixed prices, but unlike Fiverr, also allows freelancers to search through listings and find jobs on their own. Has a vast array of services offered, including translation services, creating tutorials, programming, writing, graphic design, and more.
